

Count different Sudoku

Place a digit from 1 to 9 into each of the empty squares so that each digit appears exactly once in each of the rows, columns and the nine outlined 3x3 regions.

Arrows and numbers outside gridding means how many different numbers in corresponding direction grid.



The grid is a 9x9 Sudoku puzzle. The numbers in the grid are as follows:

Red arrows and numbers indicate the count of different numbers in each direction:

- Top: 4, 4, 6 (above columns 4, 5, 6)
- Left: 5, 5, 3 (next to rows 3, 4, 5)
- Right: 3, 3, 5 (next to rows 5, 6, 7)
- Bottom: 5, 4, 3 (below columns 3, 4, 5)
