

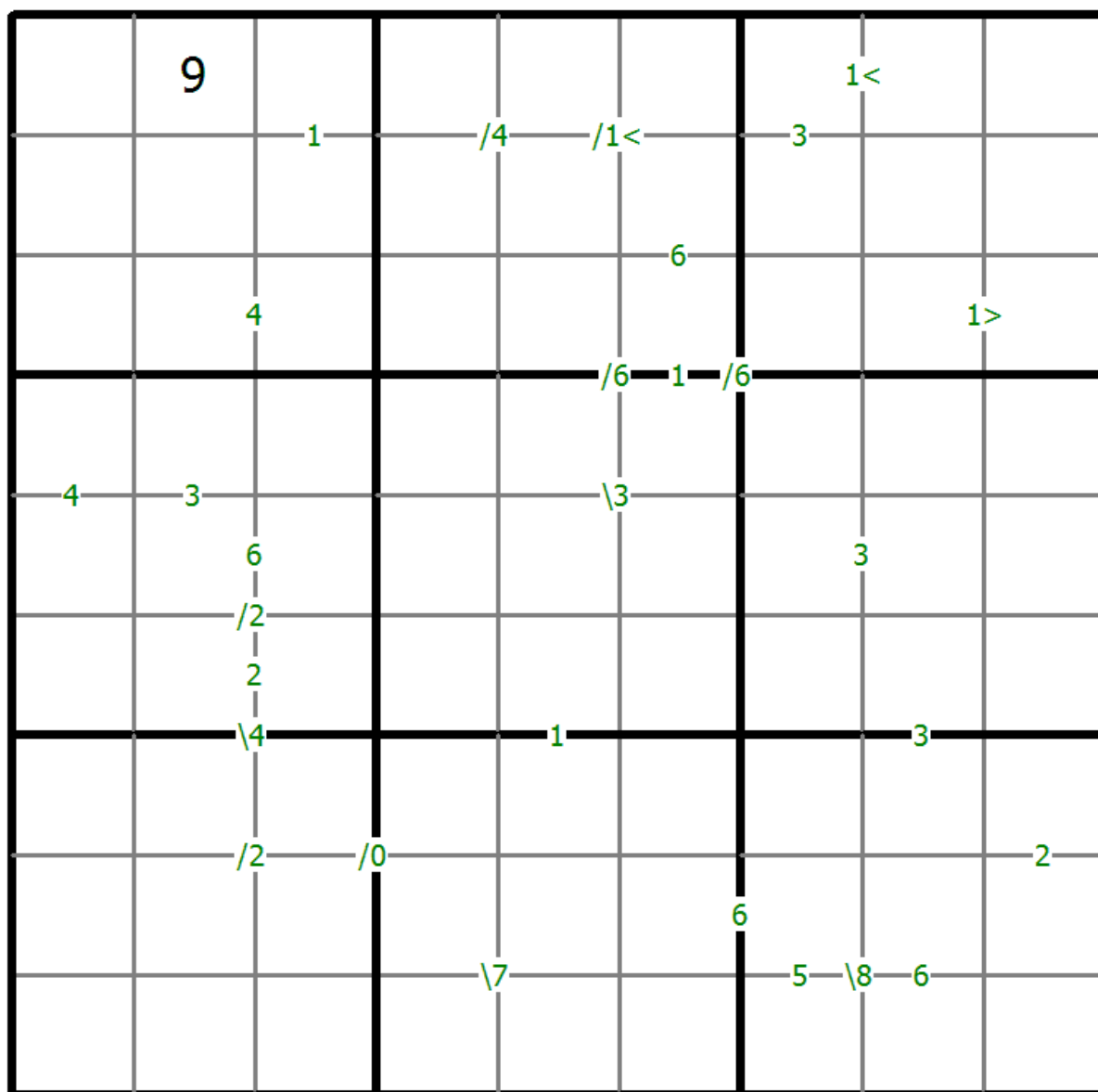
Differences Sudoku

Place a digit from 1 to 9 into each of the empty squares so that each digit appears exactly once in each of the rows, columns and the nine outlined 3x3 regions.

A number between two cells indicates the difference of the numbers in these cells. A number between four cells indicates the difference between two diagonally adjacent cells, either top left + right bottom ($\backslash$) or top right + bottom left ($/$). If one of the characters $<$ or $>$ is specified the apex of the angle points to the smaller of these numbers.
